- 5. If your application is approved you will receive 'A Conditional Offer of Place Letter' and an 'Invoice for fees'.
- 6. When your payment of fees has been received we will issue the Offer of Place and Receipt.
- 7. You can then apply for a Student Visa.
- 8. When the student visa is approved travel arrangements can be made. Please advise us of your travel details and arrival date.
