



Dear Whānau

Thank you to all whānau who completed our Returning Student Survey. We have had a strong indication that the majority of our students in Years 7-10 will be returning to school. Please be assured that we will following all health and safety guidelines set out by the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Education. Outlined below is important information relating to your daughter's return to school.

Timetable

- The attendance schedule /roster can be found in the Marist Update sent on Friday, 12 November. In addition, it will be published on the Year Level Google Classrooms and our school website tomorrow.
- From Thursday 18th of November all students will return to their KAMAR timetable.
- Students learning at school will be working in one classroom for the majority of their lessons.
- There will be no whānau meetings for the remainder of the year.
- Students who are rostered home or are not returning to school will complete work left by teachers on their online learning platform. Some teachers may choose to continue with live lessons. This will be communicated with students the week prior by each individual teacher.
- We will be having full school virtual assemblies on Wednesday mornings at 9am. Students will receive an invitation on their year level google classroom on the morning of the assembly. Our first assembly will be on the 24th of November. All students are expected to join, even if they are working from home.

Bell times

- The school day will start at 9am. Students need to go directly to their allocated classroom.
- School will finish at 3pm daily.

Uniform

- Students can wear their school uniform or PE gear for the remainder of the year.

Engagement Reports

- We will no longer send engagement reports on Fridays. End of year reports, which are a summary of all live reporting and a Whānau Teacher and Dean's report, will be sent at the end of the term.

Trips

- We are currently organising trips for our Year 9 and 10 students. Our goal is to plan these for days in which students are not already scheduled to be at school. You will receive more information over the next week.

Additional Information

- Masks are mandatory at all year levels.
- The school tuckshop will be closed for the remainder of the year.
- School buses will be running as normal. We will contact all families if this changes.
- All lockers need to be emptied by Friday 26th of November.
